PLEASE NOTE

- The programme runs on a Northern hemisphere calendar from Aug 2017 to June 2019.
- 2 x R40,000 bursaries per annum* are available for the top two candidates who apply.
- You must be willing and able to travel to Amsterdam for one semester to be accepted.
- There is the possibility of an exchange scholarship to cover the flight and the cost of living in Amsterdam.
