



INTERNSHIP: WINDOWS 10 (2-3 positions)

ICTS

The aim of the [Windows 10](#) internship contract in Information & Communication Technology Services Department (ICTS) is to provide graduates, who are interested in working in a university environment and specifically in the area of IT, technical writing, information architecture and (if applicable) business analysis, with practical work experience enabling them to compete for possible job opportunities in the future.

We are looking for 2-3 candidates with the following skills:-

- Windows 10 – expert level, including registry and full troubleshooting (preferably windows 10, otherwise Windows8)
- AD - good working knowledge
- Powershell - good working knowledge

This is urgent and start would be immediate.

Appointment to this position requires:

The person would be required to assist with software deployment to our computer labs though our standard and existing processes. A number of applications clash with one another and the candidates will require good Windows 10 registry and powershell scripting knowledge to troubleshoot this and resolve issues. AD knowledge is only required at a very basic level to determine group attributes and effect on application or configuration behaviour.

Remuneration

The monthly remuneration package is R15 000 – R30 000 per month depending on experience.

Period of Internship:

The contract will run until end February 2018.
