

Are you looking to build on your understanding of teaching and learning in higher education?

Whether it be engaging more deeply in the practice of teaching, conducting research or advancing your own knowledge of educational practice in higher education, you may want to consider one of the Higher Education Studies (HES) programmes at the University of Cape Town.

We offer both a Postgraduate Diploma and Master's degree in HES - it is also possible to enrol for one or more individual courses. The Postgraduate Diploma is aimed at students who already have advanced qualifications in their disciplinary area and are now interested in thinking about and applying a deeper educational lens to their teaching practice. Participants use theoretical tools to engage with the challenges of teaching in the current higher education classroom. The Master's degree is geared towards students who wish to obtain an advanced qualification in education or who are interested in moving into the field of higher educational research.

Areas of research and courses include:

- Learning and Teaching in Higher Education
- Higher Education Assessment and Evaluation Practice
- Curriculum and Course Design in Higher Education
- Researching Higher Education
- Knowledge and Curriculum in Higher Education

Both programmes have a coursework component and can be taken over one or two years of formal study. Classes take place in the late afternoon to accommodate working students.
